tGELF's Leadership Development Program is a two-year program designed to foster, develop, and hone leadership skills in promising young leaders. Fellows will gain experience in the following sectors: Business & Entrepreneurship, Politics & Public Service, Media, Technology & Arts, Social Service, Global Security, and Global Wisdom Traditions & Spirituality.

Who should apply?

The program is open to individuals who have completed their undergraduate or graduate degree within the past four years.

Where is it based?

We are primarily based in New Delhi, India. However, the program also includes domestic and international travel.

The program is open to all who fit the criteria mentioned and relate to its mission and vision.

The cohort will be comprised of people from India and around the world.

The acceptance process is merit-based, consisting of the application form, followed by an interview process and recommendations.

All applications are due by **March 1**.

Selected candidates will be informed by **March 31**.

The program will commence in mid-July.

Competitive compensation will be paid.

Safe and secure accommodation will be provided by tGELF for people from outside Delhi.



The program will help you:

- ◆ Build the necessary skills to lead significant projects that have real-world impact. In doing so, you will gain exposure to multiple disciplines and deal with a broad range of stakeholders.
- ◆ Participate in a rigorous ‘leadership boot-camp’ that will encourage individuals to move out of their comfort zones.
- ◆ Develop your inner-self through meetings, interactions, and workshops with leaders from the world’s global wisdom traditions.
- ◆ Connect with global leaders from a variety of fields to work together to create impact at scale.
- ◆ Deepen your knowledge through curated academic content delivered by leading professors and experts on a broad range of issues.
- ◆ Travel within India and abroad, to understand problems and issues where they exist, and to work on possible solutions.

The Global Education & Leadership Foundation focuses on finding and nurturing ethical, altruistic, action-oriented leaders. tGELF was launched in New Delhi in 2008 by the then Prime Minister of India, Dr. Manmohan Singh, and has since evolved to become India’s premier Leadership Program in schools.

We work with schools across twenty states in India and fourteen countries overseas with a long-term K-12 leadership curriculum; to date, we have reached approximately three millions students. Our Leaders Forum engages over three-hundred top university-aged students across the world.

At tGELF, we feel that young adults, with their energy and freethinking approach to problems, are the talent pool that will drive change in the future.
