

## **Team Manager – Collaborations for Impact – Education (CFI-Ed) India (University of Chicago)**

### **Job Description**

[CFI-Ed](#) is working to establish a network of sites in India to replicate the most promising educational interventions. CFI-Ed is looking to hire a Team Manager to help establish partnerships between researchers based in India, with connections to early childhood educational systems, and school systems. The primary focus of this role will be to establish and maintain a fruitful network of sites implementing interventions. This work will run in parallel to our CFI-Ed US network. The Team Manager has the opportunity to gain research experience, benefit from exposure to the University of Chicago Economics Experiments initiative, and help make a difference in India.

Not only is CFI-Ed interested in replicating educational interventions, but we anticipate that our research will inform John List's recent work on the science of scaling—or why effect sizes found in small RCTs do not always manifest when an intervention is brought to scale.

Responsibilities include:

1. Recruit sites for the replication network.
2. Work with India- and US-based researchers to identify intervention(s) to replicate
3. Manage team of researchers and RAs in India to ensure projects are designed, implemented, and studied with fidelity.
4. Perform data collection and initial cleaning/analysis.

Qualifications:

1. Master's degree in economics, policy, or related field.
2. Familiarity with and interest in educational interventions and policy concerns in India.
3. Experience working in research, randomized control trials, and navigating communication with researcher-policymaker relationships.
4. Ability to manage a team of research assistants who will help implement interventions.
5. Willingness to travel to sites across India.
